Introduction

IDC Global ("IDC") has long realized that it must recognize and protect the privacy of customers who use its network, products and services (collectively "Services"). IDC maintains strict customer information privacy policies and uses state of the art technologies to safeguard customer information and communications from unauthorized access or intrusions.

In the course of serving its customers, IDC acquires, stores and transmits customer communications and information that IDC customers may regard as private or sensitive. Customers provide some of this information - such as name, address, telephone number, and credit card data - to IDC in order to establish service. Other information - such as the customer's account status, choice of services, and customer logs - is created and maintained by IDC in the normal course of providing service. IDC also may use cookies, which are small pieces of information that a website can store in a designated file on a user's computer for various reasons. For example, IDC may use a cookie on the landing pages of products sold online which record the customer information that is required on the order form. This information is then forwarded to an internal sales tracking database within IDC. In addition, IDC may store customers' electronic mail and other communications as a necessary incident to the transmission and delivery of those communications.

Data Security

IDC is committed to protecting the confidential information entrusted to IDC by its customers. IDC does not sell information about current or former customers to anyone. IDC will protect the confidentiality of its customers' information, account information and personal communications to the fullest extent possible and consistent with the law and the legitimate interests of IDC, its partners, its employees and other customers of IDC Services. To protect the loss, misuse, and alteration of information that is collected from customers, IDC has implemented appropriate electronic, managerial, and physical procedures.

Commitment To Children's Privacy

Protecting the privacy of children is especially important to IDC. For this reason, IDC never collects or maintains information at our website (the "Site") from those IDC actually know are under thirteen (13) years of age, and no part of the IDC Site is structured to attract anyone under thirteen (13) years of age.

Linked Internet Websites

IDC is not responsible for the collection, use, or disclosure of information collected through these websites, and IDC expressly disclaims any and all liability related to such collection, use, or disclosure.

Disclosure of Customer Information and Communications

IDC will not otherwise disclose its customers' personal and account information unless IDC has reason to believe that disclosing such information is necessary to identify, make contact with, or bring legal action against someone who may be causing harm or interfering with the rights or property of IDC, IDC's customers, or others, or where IDC has a good faith belief that the law requires such disclosure.

IDC also will not, except for reasons stated below, disclose to third parties the contents of any electronic mail or other electronic communications that IDC stores or transmits for its customers. The circumstances under which IDC, in its sole discretion, will disclose such electronic customer communications are when it is necessary:

1. In order to provide service to the customer; or
2. To protect the legitimate interests of IDC and its customers; or
3. To cooperate with interception orders, warrants, or other legal process that IDC determines, in its sole discretion, to be valid and enforceable; or
4. To provide to a law enforcement agency when the contents are inadvertently obtained by IDC and appear to pertain to the commission of a crime.

IDC disclaims any intention to censor, edit or engage in ongoing review or surveillance of communications stored on or transmitted through its facilities by customers or others. IDC will, however, review, delete or block access to communications that may harm IDC, its customers or third parties. The grounds on which IDC may take such action include, but are not limited to, actual or potential violations of IDC's Acceptable Use Policy.
